

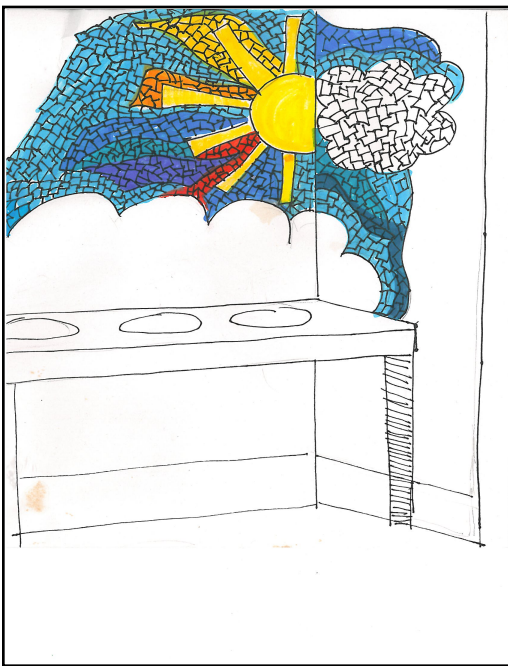


Pots for Tots
